Hi Jeff, Lori,

I did check with NPS Water Resources Division and they said that given the small number of submerged vehicles the impacts would be minimal, and localized. Their concern was a) vehicles not removed, and b) casual driving in splash zone which would contribute to grease in the water. If there were significant amounts of grease, this would be a concern. But no-one in WRD was aware of studies available that would quantify this. Higher numbers could change the analysis though.
