Dana,

I have attached two of our weekly vehicle count reports from this year. Look them over and if they are of any value to you, let me know and I can send you more. Keep in mind that the count encompasses the area from ramp 55 to Hatteras Inlet. So this is not a count of vehicles at the inlet only. I would estimate approximately 40% of the count would be at the inlet. When you see the form also note that the count is broken up to cover our entire district. You could also get a pretty good idea of how many vehicles are at Cape Point. That would be recorded from ramp 43 - 49 and I would estimate that approximately 50% of that number was at the Point.
