LARRY'S LINES

The Negotiated Rulemaking (Neg. Reg.) Committee officially met in early January and agreed to define consensus as a unanimous vote. Stakeholders will be allowed to abstain on a vote and still allow for a unanimous agreement but they will be requested to explain why they are not voting and be asked to present a proposal that might be acceptable to all. Anyone who votes "no" or an "issue" will also have to explain why and offer a proposal that might be acceptable to all. A subcommittee for agenda preparation and one for developing guidelines for an economic analysis were formed. The next scheduled meetings are February 26 (Tuesday) and 27 (Wednesday), 2008 at a site to be determined.

The NPS is also developing an Off-Road Vehicle Plan for the Seashore in case Neg. Reg. does not come up with a plan. The Neg. Reg. plan or portions of a plan that Neg. Reg. can agree on will be the preferred alternative in the NPS developed plan and NPS will fill in the holes with their own plan. NPS has published a workbook to develop alternatives that they will use for their plan. Alternatives they are looking at are in a workbook and in order to improve or at the very least maintain access your ideas are needed. One hundred people suggesting the same thought is still only one thought and this is not a popularity note. Alternatives you suggest must meet the "Purpose" and "Objectives" as described on page 7 of the "workbook". These "workbooks" can be obtained on line at <http://parkplanning.nps.gov/caha> or by calling NPS at 252-473-2111 ext. 148 and requesting a hard copy. The due date for submission has been extended until February 15, 2008. Even if you do not complete the whole workbook, your comments are still important. As an aid to those live on Hatteras Island, the Anglers Club will make arrangements to hand deliver your completed workbook, rather than your having to spend your hard-earned money to mail it to the National Park Service.

The Anglers Club web site has been hacked and when it is working again we will try and update any further news.
