> Bodie Island: The flats at the spit are currently flooded and ill-suited
> for scraping. While there has been some territorial behavior observed,
> breeding specific behavior has not been observed.
> Hatteras Island: There are two confirmed pairs at Cape Point. A three-egg
> clutch was discovered on 4/25 at Cape Point and was immediately exclosed.
> By 4/27 the nest was a four-egg clutch. A second pair has been observed
> scraping and foraging inside the pre-nesting closure. There appears to be > at least one additional scrape territory at Cape Point. There was also
> observation of a Wilson's plover at the Overwash Fans at Hatteras Inlet. > Ocracoke Island: No scrapes have been observed in the north pre-nesting
