The raccoon was trapped in a live trap this morning (4/17) on South Ocracoke. It was dispatched in Buxton.

-Marine patrol called an Ocracoke Ranger and reported seeing a raccoon on South Point on 4/9. This is the first documentation (to our knowledge) of a raccoon on Ocracoke. We will keep you posted if/when we manage to trap this individual.
