Below are questions that pertain to 36 CFR regulations. Please provide an answer to me so I can forward on to Irene Nolan.

1) Liquor and wine are not allowed in the park anymore? Does that mean bars in the park can not serve these? Or are they saying not to take "hard liquor" on the beach?

Answer: Liquor and fortified wine have never been allowed in the park due to NC laws. We do not have any bars in the park that I know of. "Hard Liquor" has never been allowed on the beach. Wine coolers, beer, and unfortified wine have always been allowed on the beach.

2) Question: What is the penalty for driving on the beach between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.?

Answer: With our current Collateral Schedule, driving on the beach would be a violation of 36 CFR (a)(1) Tresspassing which carries a \$100 fine and a \$25 dollar processing fee if the individual wants to pay it off and not have a trial.
