Subject: Night time closure at Cape Point

John McCutcheon and I went out and assessed Cape Point near the green turtle nest. Following is our management plan for the Point until the green turtle nest hatches and the closure is removed.

Cape Point Interim Closing/Opening Management

- Currently there is ~45 foot open section behind this turtle closure and the "winter" closure (i.e brown carsonite). Two portable barricades and additional signage will be used to manage the western edge of the closure to ORVs.
- Resource management staff will start tour of duty at 6:00 am and have the Cape Point closure open by 6:30 am. They will be responsible for documenting closure violations and report any in progress violations to LE staff ASAP (though call-outs) prior to 8am.
- Law enforcement staff will ensure that all vehicles have vacated the "Point" by 10:00 pm and assist RM staff with closing on a nightly basis.
- Resource management volunteers will install barricades at the western end of the green sea turtle closure. They will also rake out a 5 foot swath

behind the barricade to help determine if violations have occurred.
