I concur with Thayer's comments about converting things to FTE's. (For clarity sake, so that those who follow us will be able to understand our reasoning) it may be worth it to identify both the total FTE's and provide a break-down of how those FTE's are spread across year-round, STF, and "seasonal" (up to 6 month) positions, with the *caveat* that "While the total FTEs is expected to remain stable, the specific approach to staffing that amount of FTEs may vary over time"

Also, just want to be sure that I understand: Are the totals given (e.g., 20-22 biotechs) inclusive of all bird bio-techs AND the turtle biotechs? (As written, I assume it is the grand total, not just the bird staffing, but wanted to be sure that is what you meant?)

I would generally agree with your numbers; however my read of alternatives C and E is that C would be somewhat less than E. Maybe it should be C=20, E=22. Also, I assume this is people which includes both full-time and seasonal. We need to convert to full-time equivalents (FTEs) which is person-years. Two seasonals, given they work approximately 6 months = 1 FTE. This being the case, the numbers would be smaller - do you agree? Finally, we need to figure out, at least internally, who these people are. I know I asked this previously, but is Abra included? Are you? If not, this changes the numbers. I want to make sure that both of you are included so the full effort is considered. I assume the other three year-around staff, McGee, Bogardus and Bogardus are. Also, how are these broken down between bird and
