The numbers provided for AMOYs have once again changed from what I provided previously. We are starting to standardize how to determine if an egg in a new location is considered part of the original clutch or a new nest. We went back and corrected last year's AMOY data based on the timing of the eggs.

I only made one change to the PIPL table. Even though the annual report states that we had 11 PIPL nests in 2007 we have reduced it down to 10. We combined nest 1 and nest 2 because it should have been considered part of the same clutch/nest even though nest 2 was in a new location.

I hope this is the last time these numbers will change!
