I'll take a stab at that question. Yes, FY'09 began on October 1. We usually get a run on our Commercial Fishing Permits at the end of Nov. thru the beginning of Dec. That usually coincides with the State announcing when a significant "Commercial Fishing Season" is opening. The big one this time of year is the striped bass season that is generally only open for a couple of days. I would anticipate that both Michael Peele and William Foster will fish in 2009.
