From what I can tell (by checking resource closure requests and beach access reports) the two red knot locations on Hatteras Island (just west of the drain and the ocean beach near Sandy Bay) were closed to ORV use at the time of the survey on May 21, 2008. The Ocracoke location (just north of Ramp 67) was open to ORV use. Is that correct?

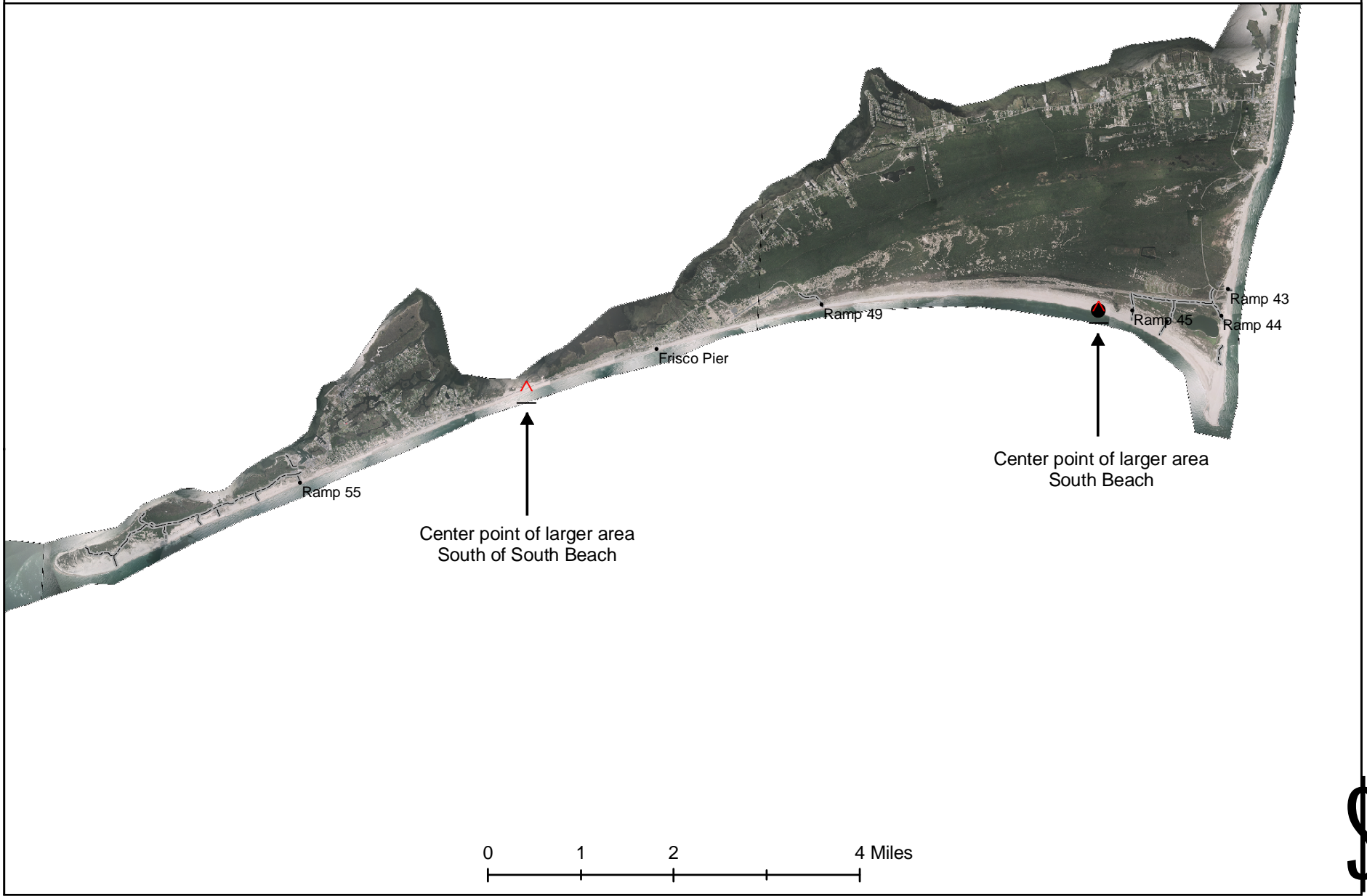
