Ed Fuller and I went out today and measured the distance from the first black mark near Ramp 59 entrance on the beach down towards the end of the black marks and we were able to get 0.3 miles without any wetlands. We measured the width of the area and it measured out at 250 feet.. We both feel that there would be plenty of room for a Interdunal road to be installed if needed. We were not able to go the last 0.2 miles towards the end. We measured from the end of the black marks to the poles out in the water and its 0.2 miles over to them.

Width is 250 Feet Length Total of Black lines is 0.4 miles Clear and high area is 0.3 miles From end of Black marks to Poles in water is 0.2 miles also.

NOTE : We looked at the South end of Ramp 59 and at this time they can 1.3 miles and would be able to drive another 0.3 miles without getting in the area where the tide comes up which would make it impassable. Hope this is what you were looking for.
