I have a one question about the 2008 NC AMOY report. In the executive summary, you state that since 1999, 47% of chick fledge in beach closures compared to 27% survival in vehicle areas. However, on page 27, the following statement seems to be in conflict:

"On Cape Hatteras From 1999 to 2009, chick survival in full beach closures was 0.482 (SE 0.056), while survival was 0.236 (SE 0.038) when the beach had an open lane for vehicles and pedestrians (Figure 2.5)."

Is there something I'm missing? Thanks for the help.
