Driving Information

All traffic rules apply and are enforced.



Motorcycles prohibited on beach from June 15 to September 15.



Beach driving requires a permit.



All vehicles must be legal for highway use.



Beach driving is not recommended.



Beach may be impassable at high tide.



May 15 - September 15
Speed limit is 15 mph unless otherwise posted.



September 16 - May 14
Speed limit is 25 mph unless otherwise posted.



Lower tire pressure to 20 PSI or less prior to entering beach.



Pedestrians have the right of way.

Beach Regulations

Observe all posted safety and wildlife protection closures.

-  Driving on dunes and vegetation is prohibited. Drive only on marked ORV routes.
-  Pets must be on a six-foot leash at all times.
-  Small beach fires are permitted below the high tideline and 100 feet from all vegetation. Extinguish all fires using water. No fires from 12 Midnight – 6 a.m.
-  All fireworks prohibited.
-  No open containers of alcoholic beverages inside motor vehicles, including pick-up truck beds. Liquor and fortified wine prohibited.
-  No camping on the beach.

Violators are subject up to \$5,000 fine and/or imprisonment of up to 6 months.
In case of emergency, dial 911.
