History: This message has been forwarded.

This is some of the information that was requested yesterday. Can you give it to the writers?

**Nest Data:**

104 nests (0 on Bodie Island, 53 on Hatteras Island, 32 on Ocracoke Island)

Of these nests, 1 was a leatherback, 2 were greens, and 100 were loggerheads. The last nest of the season was rained on when we found the tracks and we do not know if it is a loggerhead or a green, so the numbers may change.

**False Crawl Data:**

There were 101 false crawls (1 on Bodie Island, 54 on Hatteras Island, and 46 on Ocracoke Island)

**Relocation Data:**

32 of 104 nests (31%) 24 were done on Hatteras Island and 8 were done on Ocracoke Island.
