Just wanted to let you know that a new turtle nest was laid last night. The nest is northeast of Ramp 49 and was found during a routine check of a nest that is currently hatching. The tracks were rained on, so we are not sure whether the nest was laid by a loggerhead or green turtle, although we think that it is probably a green. We will have to see how this nest does....this late in the season the chance of it being successful is minimal.

This nest brings us up to 104 nests for the Seashore (0 Bodie Spit, 19 Bodie-Hatteras, 53 Hatteras, and 32 Ocrcoke). The false crawls remain at 101.
