Mr. Keene,

Your inquiry to N.C. State Historic Sites has been forwarded here to the State Historic Preservation Office.

What was your source for the numbers you cite for historic sites and districts within Cape Hatteras National Seashore? I believe the numbers may be taken from a report that includes places identified in a study or studies but that have not yet received any official designation as "historic" by listing in the National Register of Historic Places. If such a report was your source for the numbers, it seems that the administrative offices of the seashore would be the most likely location for the report. I am copying this note to Renee Gledhill-Earley, our environmental review coordinator, who is away this week but who may have knowledge of such a study undertaken in the seashore.

I have conducted a search on our maps in GIS and see only three National Register listings that are actually within the boundaries of the Cape Hatteras National Seashore. If you include Cape Lookout National Seashore, there are a few more. However, I cannot be certain that the boundaries for the seashores I downloaded from NCOneMap are current and complete.
