Hi Sandy,

I attempted to send an email Nov 23, which apparently failed to make it through the C3 Portal.

1. The text in the SNHA does not match the SOF for Floodplains regarding: the exact location of any proposed improvements is not known. The NPS will consult with NCNHP when the Seashore has identified specific locations for constructing or relocating ramps, interdunal roads, or parking lots.
2. I compared the locations in the SOF proposed improvements locations with the SNHAs locations:
  - New ramps with parking established at 24 and 26. Would be within the unregistered "Hatteras Island - Middle Section" SNHA
  - New ramp with parking established at 32.5. Would be within the unregistered "Hatteras Island - Middle Section" SNHA
  - NPS or Dare County to establish new parking at old Coast Guard Station site. Could be planned so that it would not be within the Registered "Turtle Pond and Cape Hatteras Lighthouse Pond" SNHA, but would be adjacent to the northern boundary of this SNHA.
  - West of the overwash fan, Pole Road re-routed toward the sound to provide natural barrier to bird nesting area south of road. I'm not 100% sure, but this sounds like it would be within the Registered "Hatteras Sand Flats" SNHA or at the very least adjacent to the east boundary of the SNHA. There is also a known archeological site nearby (Fort ??? ruins).
  - New interdunal road extending southwest and northeast of the south end of Pole Road established to provide access to False Point and inlet. Would be within the Registered "Hatteras Sand Flats" SNHA.
  - New interdunal road established parallel to the beach extending from ramp 59 for 0.3 mile northeast toward the inlet, with parking at the terminus. Would be within the Registered "Ocracoke Island - Eastern Section" SNHA

Turtle Pond and Cape Hatteras Lighthouse Pond (registered) and the unregistered Hatteras Island - Middle Section should be added to the sentence "Among the registered SNHAs potentially relevant to this ORV Management Plan/EIS are Cape Hatteras Point, Hatteras Sand Flats, Ocracoke Island - Eastern End, and Ocracoke Island - Western End Sand Flats" in the SNHA text.
3. The SOF doesn't mention ramps, roads, or parking lots in the Ocracoke Island - Western End Sand Flats SNHA, but there was a comment in the DEIS about potential activities within that area. I'm sorry that I can't recall what text in the DEIS Chapter 4 made me concerned about the western portion of Ocracoke Island.
