Matthew,

Thank you for the sea turtle annual figures that you sent.

I am using only your figures for the years 2000 thru 2009 as this period represents a period of consistent sea turtle management at CHNS. In looking at your statewide figures, I notice the following:

- 1. When I add your figures for the total number of nests (all species) listed each year since 2000, the total agrees in only two of the ten years with those shown in the 2009 CHNS annual sea turtle report page 8 (which are attributed to you). This may not seem too important except that, as you are well aware, these figures are used by USF&W to calculate the percent of nests laid at CHNS as compared to the total laid in the state.
- 2. When I add your figures for "Nests Relocated" for all species each year and compare these totals with those reported by just CHNS and CALO, the statewide totals are less than just the two Seashores in three of the ten years. In fact the statewide total of 56 in 2002 would seem to reflect only the 56 relocated nests reported by CALO in their annual report.
- 3. When I add your figures for "False Crawls" for all species each year and compare these totals with those reported by just CHNS and CALO, the statewide totals are less than just these two Seashores in six of the ten years.
- 4. With regards to the statewide figures shown for "Nests with 0% hatch success", I can only conclude that since the other statewide totals do not seem to reflect complete data, these figures are questionable.

Frankly, I would have expected that these statewide figures would have been at your fingertips and had already been double checked for accuracy to reflect statewide sea turtle activity. The "Handbook for Sea Turtle Volunteers in North Carolina" on page 19 states "All permit holders must submit an annual report of all activities involving sea turtles or their nests." I can understand that you may not get absolute compliance with NCWRC mandated reporting requirements, but the figures you supplied would seem to show either lack of enforcement or poor record keeping on the part of NCWRC.

I hope that you can clear up the above listed discrepancies as soon as possible.
