Please schedule a 1-hour conference call, either middle of next week (need to keep Thursday open for court preparation) or early the week of March 22, with Sandy Hamilton, Mike Stevens, Jason Waanders, Carol Mansfield, Steve Thompson, and Paul Stevens to discuss the Regulatory Flexibility Act (RFA) requirements for the proposed ORV rule. The issue: Do we need to do an RFA analysis for any small businesses that would be directly regulated by the proposed ORV rule (e.g., if CUAs would be required to get an ORV permit [yes]; or if the references to commercial fishermen in the reg would create new requirements for commercial fishermen [yes; fairly minor new requirements, such as fish house receipts needed in order for commercial fishermen to obtain a +/- 2 hour modification of the night driving restriction])?

From **Steve**, we would need a list of current CUAs that operate vehicles on the beach, so we can discuss the full range of small businesses that would be directly regulated by the new regulation.
