## Public Comment Period for NPS Draft EIS for Off-Road Vehicle Management Plan Ends May 11, 2010

As previously announced, the public comment period for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Off-Road Vehicle Management Plan ends Tuesday, May 11, 2010. This announcement confirms the respective deadlines for both electronic and written comments on the DEIS.

Electronic comments may be submitted online until midnight (Mountain Daylight Time) on May 11, 2010 at the NPS Planning, Environment and Public Comment (PEPC) web site by visiting <a href="http://parkplanning.nps.gov/caha">http://parkplanning.nps.gov/caha</a>, clicking on \*Open for Comment, clicking on the Off-Road Vehicle Management Plan /EIS, and then clicking on Comment on Document. NPS encourages commenting electronically through PEPC.
