We have received your letter and CD containing 16,453 comments that The Wilderness Society has gathered regarding the DEIS for the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Off-Road Vehicle Management plan. While we appreciate receiving your correspondence, NPS is not accepting bulk comments in any format (hard copy or electronic) that are submitted on behalf of others. The methods for submitting comments on the DEIS were described in the Federal Register Notice and related press release, which stated the following:

The NPS will accept comments on the DEIS until midnight (Mountain Daylight Time) May 11, 2010. Electronic comments may be submitted on-line at the NPS Planning, Environment and Public Comment (PEPC) web site by visiting <http://parkplanning.nps.gov/caha>, clicking on ***Open for Comment**, clicking on the **Off-Road Vehicle Management Plan /EIS**, and then clicking on **Comment on Document**. NPS encourages commenting electronically through PEPC. If you wish to submit your written comments in hard copy (e.g. in a letter), you may send them by U.S. Postal Service or other mail delivery service, which must be postmarked by May 11, or hand-deliver them by May 11 to: Mike Murray, Superintendent, Cape Hatteras National Seashore, 1401 National Park Drive, Manteo, NC 27954. Comments will not be accepted by fax, email, or in any other way than those specified above. Bulk comments in any format (hard copy or electronic) submitted on behalf of others will not be accepted. *(underline added for emphasis)*
