# Nancy,

The one (new) connector indicated on map 4 would be the ORV route between the extended interdunal road and the ORV corridor on the beach. We would allow vehicle parking at various points along the interdunal road and pedestrian access to the beach (when no resource closures are in effect). These would generally be at least 0.9 mile west of Ramp 45 (because of wetland issues east of that point) then occur periodically over to Ramp 49. We are not prepared to precisely identify or map those locations in the FEIS, but would eventually do so in a subsequent "access infrastructure" EA. For now Map 4 should simply show the ORV route connector, but not identify pull-out parking or any new developed foot trails along the interdunal road.
