I have added my comments into the version you provided below. As requested, I added a paragraph on why relocation or a captive breeding program for PIPLs would not be a good idea (Pg. 128). One other thing that I saw in a number of places was a reference to 105 meter buffer around turtle nests. When I read this I think of a circular buffer as we have for birds. I modified this to read 105 meter wide buffers. Table 10 (Pg 125) of the DEIS correctly explains the way buffers will be installed—"On the landward side of the nest, the closed area will be expanded to 15 meters from the nest where possible, but no less than 10 meters landward from the nest."
