Doug,

In reviewing Table 8 and reflecting on some of the comments received, we realized that there was an unrealistic and/or undesirable vehicle/trailer/vehicle length standard under Vehicle Characteristics. The DEIS version of Alternative F would have allowed a vehicle with 3 axles and up to 30 ft. long to pull a trailer with 2 axles with no limit on combined vehicle length. It is difficult to imagine a 30 ft long vehicle with 3 axles other than a motorhome (e.g., a full-sized Chevy Suburban is only 18.5 ft long). My recollection is that the large vehicle size probably originated from one of the Committee members familiar with ORV use at CACO where motorhomes are allowed in the self-contained vehicle area and/or ASIS where they have a vehicle length of 26 ft (not sure why). In any case, we are not planning to allow self-contained vehicle camping or motorhomes on the beach at CAHA, so we have revised the language in Table 8 so it is simpler and more clear.
