I concur, except that on Map 2 Alt F, I checked with Paul Stevens and we need to stick with "**0.1 mile south of Rodanthe Pier**" as the demarcation between the VFA and the seasonal ORV route (and should change the text in Table 8, and elsewhere if needed, to ensure that we consistently say **0.1 mile south** of the pier, not "at the pier").

Hi Lori.

Here are my comments on FEIS maps (unless Mike wants to overrule me, which is fine):

Map 2 Alt F: Seasonal ORV route should start at the Rodanthe Fishing Pier (table 7-1 says .1mile south of pier, Table 8 says it starts at pier)

Maps 3 and 4 for alternatives A-E: Kite Point is labeled incorrectly. See correct label on Alt-F

Map 4, Alt D: the trails/roads south of CP campground disappeared on this version of the maps. Was that intentional?

Map 5 Alts A-E: NC-12 disappears in the village. Should continue to the harbor like in Alt F

Map 5 Alt F: Call-out at Hatteras Spit should use same language as other call-out text ("Seasonal ORV route" etc.)

Map 7 alts A,B,C,E : Seasonal route south of R72 goes into the water
