Lori,

The item for CH 4 p. 397 (lines 37 and 39) on text reading "virtually eliminating" and "ample time" respectively:

I've discussed these with Britta. Please change your text ... "until 7:00 am, this would allow Seashore staff ample time to survey the beach for nests prior to the onset of ORV use, virtually eliminating the possibility that crawls would be obscured by ORV tracks, causing nests to be missed and therefore not protected as has occurred in the past." to the following:

..."until 7:00 am, this would generally allow Seashore staff time to survey the beach for nests prior to the onset of ORV use, reducing the possibility that crawls would be obscured by ORV tracks, causing nests to be missed and therefore not protected as has occurred in the past."

The new text above deletes "ample," inserts "generally," and substitutes "reducing" for "virtually eliminating"

The rationale for these changes is that on days when there are multiple nests the sea turtle patrol may not be able to clear the whole beach before 7:00.

Please check to see if this change carries into in any other place in the FEIS.
