Dear Mike,

This link was placed on the Red Drum Board by a person in New Jersey. We visited this site in the Spring and walked among the birds and ponds. There were three plover exclosures at the time. I haven't been able to get any data from there yet. You may wish to look into this. I would appreciate any information your resource staff has/can get.

As you know, I have urged you in the past to create such a habitat here at CAHA. I have presented a recommendation for use of the same herbicide also. It is interesting that the state environmental department and the Army Corps of Engineers are funding it.

I still have several emails from Thayer Brioli about an application to start a token project. Apparently, nothing has been done yet. It is such a shame that suffering continues here when a more suitable resource protection method could be initiated.
