Once the new ORV plan is implemented, the following **20** ocean-side ORV ramps will need the standard 2-panel regulatory signs:

- Ramps # 2.5, 4, 23, 25.5, 27, 30, 32.5, 34, 38, 43, 44, 47.5, 49, 55, 59.5, 63, 67, 68, 70, and 72.

Therefore, I think we should order **22** copies each of the beach regulations and driving regulations signs, so we have at least two spares when implementation begins.
