Mike,

Sometimes you want to prohibit something everywhere. Your suggested edit, for example:

*Can I ride my motorcycle, all-terrain vehicle (ATV), or utility vehicle (UTV) off of Seashore roads?*

**No. The operation of motorcycles, ATVs, and UTVs by the public in the Seashore would be prohibited on designated ORV routes.**

In this case I think you want to totally prohibit ATVs and UTVs from CAHA - not just on CAHA designated routes. True if they're off route, you can cite them for off designated route driving, but why not retain the option of citing for prohibited ATV/UTV use.
