Russ,

This is what the FEIS Glossary says:

Vehicle free area (VFA) —An area within the Seashore that has not been designated as an ORV route. Nonessential vehicle/ORV use is prohibited in VFAs.

Note: I suggest we delete the second sentence (i.e., Nonessential vehicle/ORV use is prohibited in VFAs.) for the definition in the CFR, since it would require us to define "nonessential vehicle" (which is defined in the Glossary) and seems unnecessary for the purposes of the CFR since the rule will say that ORV use is prohibited except on designated ORV routes and areas. In other words, use the following definition in the CFR:

Vehicle free area (VFA) —An area within the Seashore that has not been designated as an ORV route.
