Doug's comment was:" I know this is straight from the document, but is there a way to explain what "relative bird use" means here?"

Do you have any suggestion for tweaking the wording (e.g., adding a word or two) so that "relative bird use" is more clear?

<u>1 mile south of ramp 23 to 1 mile north of ramp 34</u> - The NPS examined this area and retained one portion as closed to ORVs year-round, based on **relative bird use**. However, part of this area will remain open to ORV use year round because of the desire to provide areas for ORV access where the use could be best accommodated, since an objective of this plan is to manage ORV use to provide for a variety of visitor use experiences.
