In light of the devastation by Hurricane Irene and the clean-up and repair that will be on going for months if not years, I am formally requesting that you do everything in your power to extend the public comment period on the Proposed ORV Rule (RIN 1024-AD85). Many of the people most affected by Irene are the same people that will be most affected by the Proposed OV Rule. A minimum extension of 30 days and up to 90 days would seem appropriate. The loss of notes, files, computers, etc. as well as the distractions of recovery will make it difficult if not impossible for many to meet the published September 6, 2011 deadline.
