There is still one nest between Ramp 43 and Ramp 44. The nest began hatching on October 15th. A few more hatchlings emerged last night. They plan to excavate the nest on October 20th.

In addition, there is another late nest near the groins that partially hatched last night.....but no one probably cares about that one because it doesn't affect ORV use.

Also, there is another nest north of Ramp 4 which has not hatched yet.....and Piatak will be expanding soon....this week I believe he said. Therefore, through access will not occur after tomorrow's excavation. I did notify Jim Keene of tomorrow's excavation at 11:00 am. Would you like for me to join Piatak for that excavation?

Anyway, the few "late bloomers" that remain on the Seashore seem to be slowly hatching...but viable.
