David ,

The plan has been to close Ramp 45 at Location A on your map and allow pedestrians to park at the back of the campground and walk out the road to the beach. If you think it would be manageable to allow ORVs to go to Location B, we could discuss it internally. My initial thoughts are that B would be preferable to ORV operators, but much less desirable to pedestrians who don't have an ORV. They would have to park in the back of the campground and walk out a narrow ORV route with two-way traffic to get to the beach. I don't think we want to create/ build a new pedestrian trail through the wetland for this purpose. We were planning to make use of the existing infrastructure for this purpose.

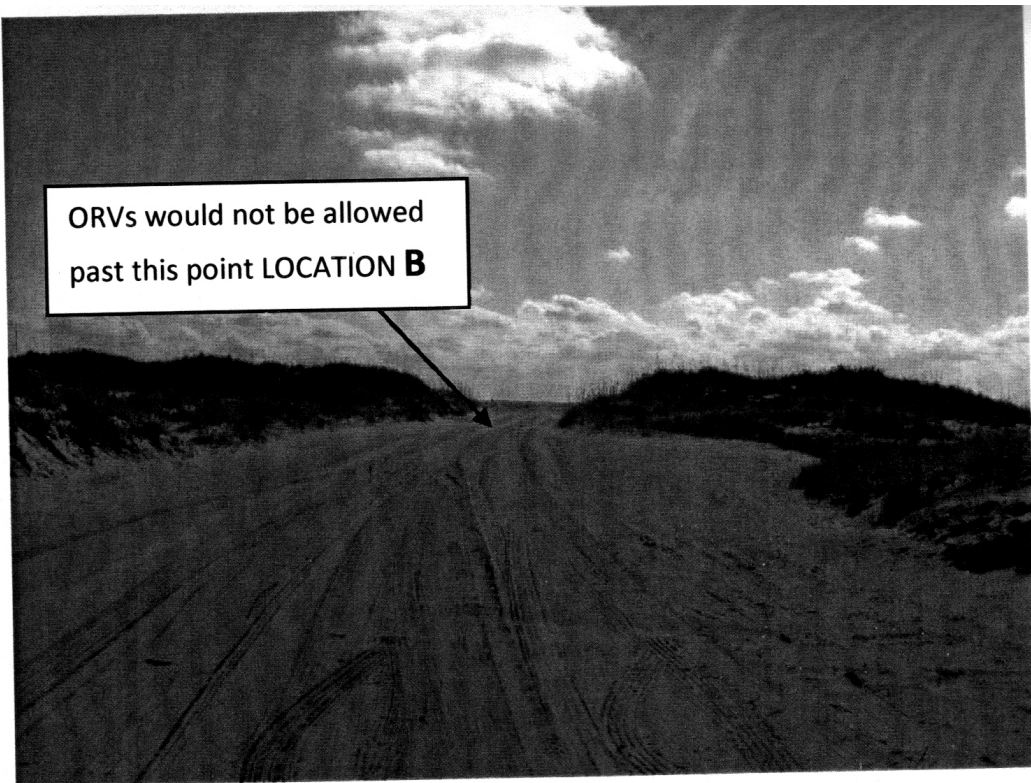
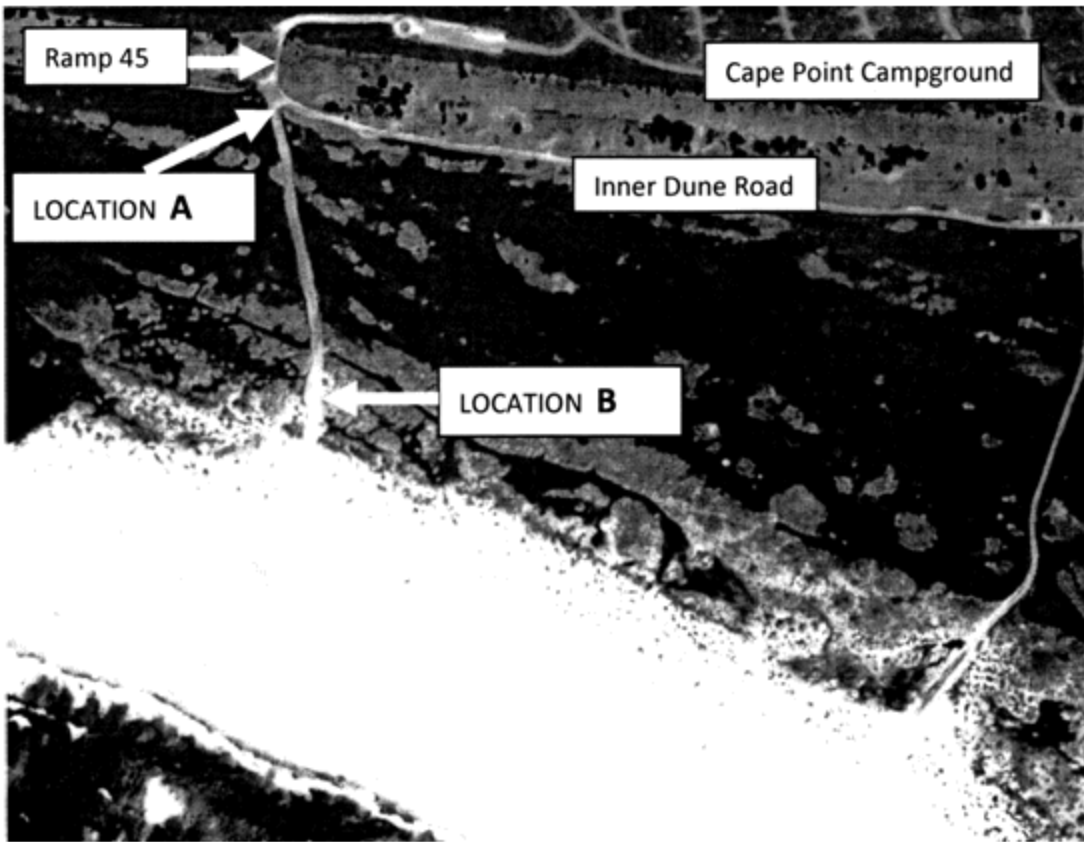
