A problem with the vehicle counter was identified in late May. Repairs were completed on June 17th. Due to not having a complete month of accurate data this has resulted in a decrease in June visitation. The decrease in numbers for the visitor center is attributed to a discrepancy in the June 2009 stats. The reported number (14,260) was the raw data and not divided by 2 to account for visitors both entering and exiting the VC. A corrected number of 7,130 for June 2009 would result in a 13% increase in visitation for 2010. Film presentations will not be available during the VC renovations due to not having audiovisual capability in the temporary facility.
