Would be hard to do it without Sidney, since (my impression is that) he was heavily involved in developing the green caucus proposal. If Sid is comfortable with Destry and Burnie covering the meeting, (or if Walker can fill in for him), then it may work fine (without at least Walker there, I doubt Burnie and Destry can "negotiate" any points or respond to any other ideas without someone from Audubon there). You could ask Sid about meeting without him and/or see if Walker could cover it.

My impression is that Jim Keene and Dave Goodwin are working with John Couch on a revised Routes and Areas proposal for the ORV/access caucus. If that is the case, and their working proposal is no longer "Frank's", then it is probably okay to proceed without him. May need to check with Dave or Jim to confirm status of their revised proposal and whether they are okay with meeting without Frank.
