Is there ANY indication that the open access folks have made a major reevaluation of their position or is there important new information which pertains to the situation? If not we are in for more frustration and disappointment, despite the best efforts of you, Robert, Pat, Mike, etc. This is not the fault of anyone. All participants seem to be doing their best to represent their constituents.

I have trouble believing that other folks really enjoy being asked about the same issues under the same conditions over and over again. It seems to reinforce conflicts, which is not in anyone's interest. Fundamentally, I think that we have different values and project the future differently. I am disappointed that the Park Service reversed its position on the need to close the process by the end of this month, except for a possible meeting to wrap up any outstanding minor details on February 3. Is there any guarantee that the process will end in February?

Having said that, if there is a solid indication that the open access folks have reevaluated their position, or that there is important new information which pertains to the situation, I will happily participate in the meetings next week.
