Mike.

I was able to get the necessary surgery for my right hip scheduled and the procedure will be done on 2/23.

I am devastated that I will not be able to complete this process after having attended all but one day of the meetings since before the inception of the committee. I still hope that a balance between the critical players can be reached and believed that I might be able to assist in the integration process during the next two weeks. Unfortunately that will not be the case.

Relative to the beaches in front of the villages, I believe we had worked out a very well supported agreement for the Northern and Southern beaches as memorialized in the record. The Southern beaches if there is agreement to ever open them should not be opened before 11/1 and should be re closed on 3/15 as we had almost unanimously agreed to in

the last subcommittee meeting, with the Northern beaches opened on 10/1 and closed on 4/30. I did support and will continue to support this as the compromise consensus recommendation. I do believe that the reopening of the Southern beaches to driving after such a long period of the being "off limits" is a serious error on the part of the NPS and one that will serve as a lightening rod for challenge. I believe that the NPS should keep the status quo relative to this issue and the historical record affecting this issue.

I thank you for the opportunity to serve on this committee and for the ability for me to represent a very neutral point of view. I wish you and all the participants good luck and success in the final weeks of deliberation. There is a Latin phrase that seems to represent what has been attempted. "Ad Asper, Per Asper".
