Per our last Committee meeting, Walker sent us the following regarding pedestrian uses in the 50 m buffer areas for non-breeding shorebirds.

"The following activities are compatible with the non-breeding shorebird resource areas: beach walking, birding, kayaking, kite boarding, paddle boarding, photography, picnicking, sailing, shelling, stargazing, sunbathing, surfing, swimming, wildlife viewing and wind surfing.

As previously stated, human disturbance in these areas will have to be monitored and should any single activity or collective activities become excessive, NPS will have to implement seasonal or additional restrictions."
