Bodie Island

• Page 1: No predetermined closure date; <u>March 15 Pre-nesting closure with Corridor</u> (as in NPS ALT E) until <u>first sign of bird</u> territory behavior (scraping, mating, etc.) <u>by any shorebird</u>; then completely closed from the spit to the northern extent of the pre-nesting <u>and continuing around to the bait pond at the west</u>; reopens per SM2.

Hatteras Island

- Pages 4-8: Ramp 25-33 and a one-mile area centered on the Haulover Rd closed to ORVs year-round (white); remainder open
 to the northern end of Buxton
- Page 7-8:
 - Move and expand parking lot shown on 2/13/09 map to the fish cleaning table area
 - Lighthouse to 0.2 miles north of Ramp 43 closed to ORVs year-round
