The Solicitors, Sandy Hamilton, and I have reviewed the draft language about the subcommittees and think it is fine as is. It is simple, factual, and makes no judgments about the functionality of any of the subcommittees.

It would not be appropriate for the facilitators to make editorial comments or footnotes about the functionality of any of the subcommittees in the summary report, so as DFO I've directed the facilitators to stick with their original language. If it is important to you, feel free to comment about it in your addendum submission. While the addendum is, among other things, an opportunity for committee members to comment on process issues, what would be most helpful to NPS and me would be for the members to take advantage of this last formal RegNeg committee input opportunity to summarize their respective final ORV management recommendations for NPS to consider. The next formal opportunity for input will be under the NEPA process during the public comment period after the DEIS is released in the fall.
